Entry:

Upon payment you will receive a receipt and a WINDOW IDENTIFICATION STICKER WITH ENTRY NUMBER. This must be placed prominently on the left hand corner of the windscreen, or motorcycle headlight, for entry to marshalling yard on the day and also to gain entry to the Kadina Oval at the end of the Cavalcade. **Please remove previous stickers.**

No entry window stickers posted after Friday, 12th May – collect from entry tent well before 10am on day.

Plaques:
